**Vaccinations against toxoplasmosis and enzootic abortion need to be given at least 3 weeks before the breeding season, so get you order in soon.**



## Lung worm

*August often sees a significant level of clinical lungworm disease. Husk in youngstock is likely to happen from now until turnout unless they have been protected by Huskvac.*

Unprotected stock should be inspected daily and any signs of coughing must be treated straight away to prevent checks in growth or even deaths.

Pour-on wormers are the most convenient treatment; Enzovex is a new brand of very competitive Ivermectin pour-on treatment at £45.00 for 2½ litres, available from the surgery.
